**Circular
of the Chancellor of Gdańsk University of Technology

adopting the Rules of public order for persons present on the premises of Gdańsk University of Technology.

§1 The Rules of public order for persons present on the premises of Gdańsk University of Technology are adopted, as set out in the Annex to this circular.

§2 This circular shall enter into force on the date of its adoption.

Rules of public order for persons present on the premises of Gdańsk University of Technology

§1

General provisions

1. This document (hereinafter referred to as the "Rules") sets out the public order rules for all persons present on the premises of Gdańsk University of Technology (hereinafter referred to as the "University") who are not University employees. It applies in particular to:
 - 1) students, regular University collaborators, school pupils and their supervisors,
 - 2) persons participating in events held at the University (including those co-organized by the University), such as conferences, showings, workshops, outdoor events, meetings, open days, and similar activities.
2. This document sets out the public order rules pertaining to the safety of people and property and the rules of conduct to follow in case of public order incidents.

§2

Rules of conduct

1. All persons who are present on University premises shall:
 - 1) call for medical assistance (dial 112 or 999) or the fire department (112 or 998) in the event of a direct threat to human life or health, and immediately report the incident to the Security Office using one of the following 24/7 contact numbers:
 - a) 19 789 for mobile phone calls,
 - b) +48 58 347 14 32 for external calls,or
 - c) notify the nearest entry control point or guard,
 - 2) immediately report any public order incidents to the Security Office using one of the 24/7 contact numbers provided in point 1(a)–(c);
 - 3) act in a way that does not endanger their own safety or that of others and comply with OHS regulations and the provisions of these Rules;
 - 4) respect University property;
 - 5) comply with the ban on using alcohol and smoking, including novel tobacco products and electronic cigarettes.
2. All persons who are present on University premises are prohibited to:
 - 1) bring in or store materials or items considered dangerous or posing a threat to their health or life or that of others, in particular: all types of weapons, ammunition, explosives, pyrotechnic products, tools and devices whose use could endanger human life or health, and items designed to incapacitate people by means of electric energy. This list is not exhaustive, and the Security Office employees are authorized to prohibit other items from being brought onto University premises;
 - 2) bring in, use, or store narcotic drugs, psychotropic substances, new psychoactive substances, substitute substances, or other intoxicants;
 - 3) litter the University premises;
 - 4) conduct any commercial, for-profit, advertising, or political activity without prior consent from the University authorities.

§3

Final provisions

1. The University does not provide storage for weapons, ammunition, explosives, pyrotechnic devices, tools or devices that may pose a threat human life or health, or items designed to incapacitate people using electric energy.

3. Failure to comply with these Rules may result in the following actions by the Security Office personnel:
 - 1) verifying the reason for a person's presence on University premises;
 - 2) requesting identification to confirm the person's identity;
 - 3) requesting the person to leave the University premises;
 - 4) detaining persons who pose an immediate and clear threat to life, health, or protected property, in order to hand them over to the police immediately;
 - 5) using direct coercive measures where necessary.
4. Entering the University premises means acceptance of these Rules.
